

# Metoprolol to propranolol conversion

The maximal effects of **metoprolol**, nadolol, and **propranolol** were similar but the drugs differed in potency (dosage producing 50% of maximal effect, calculated from the dose-effect relationships; nadolol, 0.3 mg/day; **metoprolol**, 120 mg/day; **propranolol**, 47 mg/day). Similar relationships were found with drug plasma .
